Special Instructions for **ALL CLASSES**:

- **Classes are 6-7** hours of training. All dogs need to be following their veterinarian's immunization recommendation for his/her age.
- **Our motto is:** We teach the human end of the leash at least as much as the dog end!
Handler Age:
- **Manners class** handlers must be at least 14 years old [or have permission from the instructor prior to the first night of class].
- **Leash Walk/Recall class** handlers must be adults.

Manners and Skills for All Dogs

This is a beginning level class for any age dog. There will be lots of time for questions and problem solving for basic manners issues. The class will teach you how to develop your dog's attention to you. Skills that this class will help you get started on include walking on leash, sit, down, and come when called. This class is not appropriate for dogs that are aggressive to other dogs or people, on or off leash. **HANDLER MUST ATTEND THE FIRST MANNERS CLASS 2 hour session WITHOUT DOGS UNLESS THEY HAVE PERMISSION IN ADVANCE FROM THE TRAINERS.**

Leash Walking and Recall Skills Focus

This class is for owners who have already taken a Basic Manners **or** Obedience Class and who want to learn how to improve their dog's leash walking skills **as well as** learn how to teach an emergency recall. We will explore a variety of techniques, and work individually with each dog and handler team. **The first class will include dogs.
